Re: Continuity of Food Service for our students

Dear Laingsburg Families,

Starting on Friday, March 20, through Friday, April 3, Laingsburg Community Schools will provide food service meals (breakfast and lunch) on Tuesdays and Fridays for ALL children, 18 years of age and under, free of charge.

Breakfast meal components may include string cheese, fruit, grains (such as a cereal bar), cereal and milk. Lunch meal components will include “Ready to Eat” meals or “Shelf Stable” meals which could include deli meat sandwiches, vegetarian options, fruits, vegetables, and milk.

Breakfast and Lunch meals will be available for curbside pick up at our Early Childhood Education Center (ECEC) located at 320 Grand River, between the hours of 11 am – 1 pm on Tuesdays and Fridays. Please utilize the drive off of Woodhull Street and pull up to the cafeteria door. There will be no cafeteria dining available.

Also, I wanted to share some important community resources that may be available for families in need of additional support.
