Online registration has begun for the 2017 Feelin' Good Mileage Club. This process only takes a few minutes and it allows your child to participate in the mileage club. Register your child online by March 6 for a chance to win a \$50 gas card. You can also register by filling out the registration form and mailing it in to Sparrow Health and Wellness. This is a free program for the school. This 7-week program will begin on April 10 and continue through May 26. During these seven weeks, your child will have the opportunity to walk or run during designated recesses or lunch periods to earn Toe Tokens!

At the beginning of the program, your child will receive a Mileage Club punch card at school to track miles. Look for regular emails that will inform you of your child's progress throughout the Mileage Club. 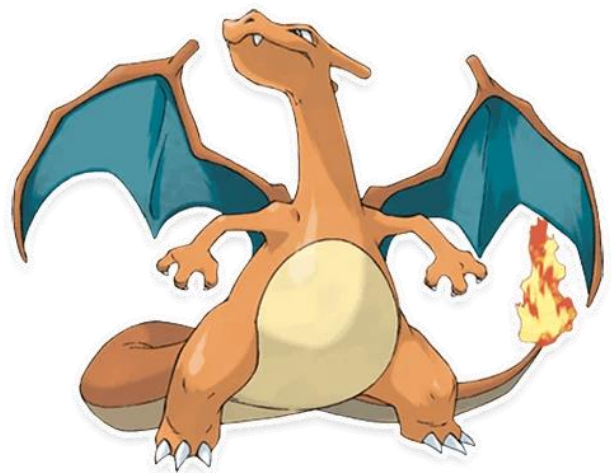
